



Glacier 3000; the 3rd edition of the Freeridedays.ch enjoys increasing popularity

Gstaad, March 19, 2009. The legendary Freeridedays.ch will take place for the third time on the powder runs of Glacier 3000 on April 4th and 5th. In addition to freeriding in guided groups, freeriders will enjoy an abseiling adventure, equipment testing and spectacular shows, both on the slopes and in the air.

Deep powder freeriding with pro riders and mountain guides, abseiling over a 60 m drop, ski and snowboard testing, watching an acrobatic show and going to the event party at the Chlösterli make the Freeridedays.ch at Glacier 3000 such a unique event. On the weekend of April 4th and 5th, this event will take place for the third year in a row. The Glacier 3000 freeride area offers participants unforgettable runs off the main slopes. Safety and prevention are the top priority at Glacier 3000. As a result, participants will be equipped with the newest freeride tools. They will also be accompanied by professional mountain guides, who will also help participants learn how to assess an avalanche risk and to discuss proper conduct, both on and off the main slopes.

13 manufacturers of skis and snowboards will be there to let freeriders test their newest models. Other attractions include acrobatic shows with Woopys and Wingsuits. It is still possible to sign up (www.freeridedays.ch). However, there are only a few spaces remaining.
