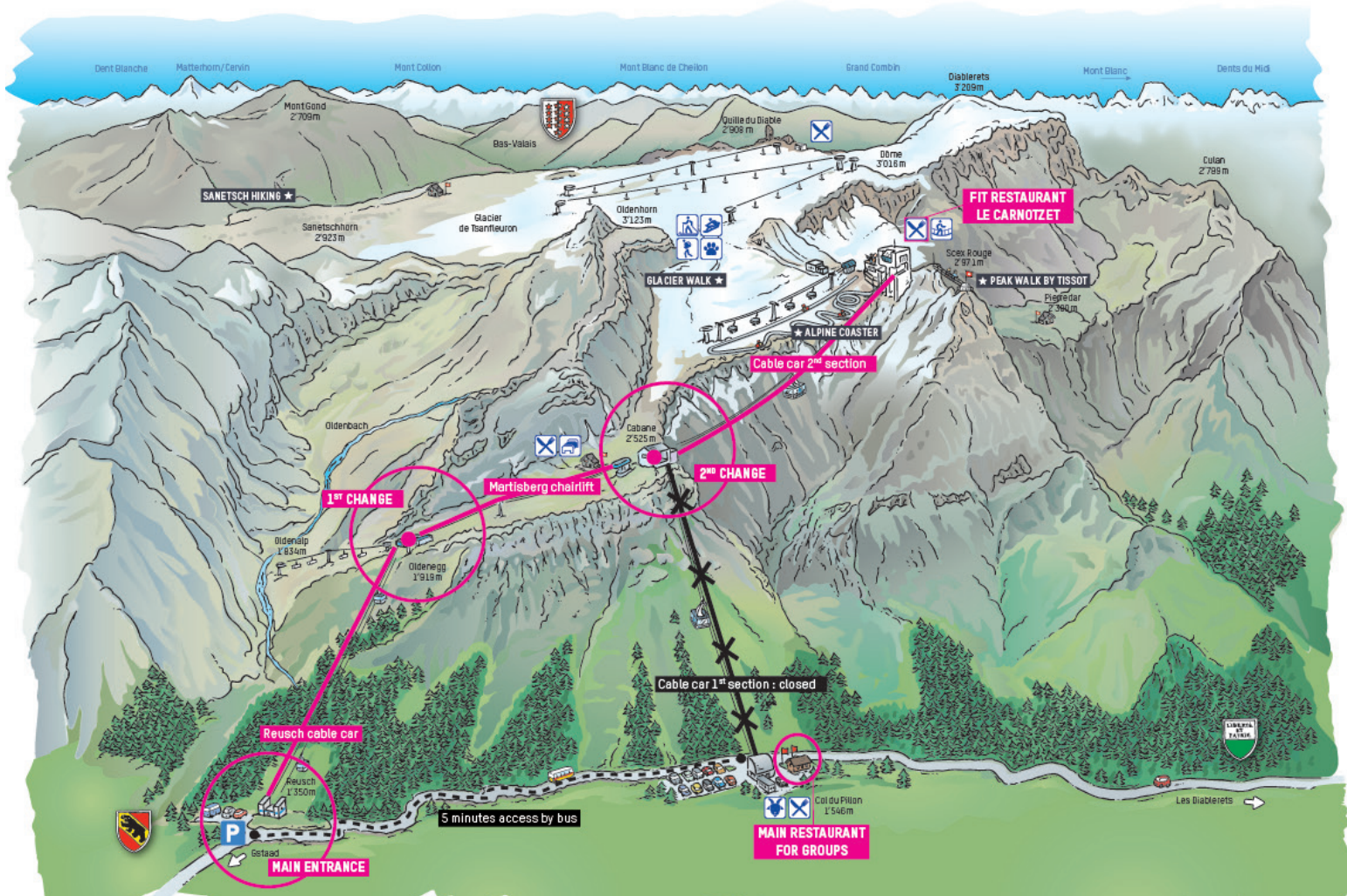

WE ARE OPEN! ACCESS THROUGH REUSCH

During that period, the 1st section of the cable car to Glacier 3000 will be **temporary closed** due to maintenance. Access will be possible with the cable car «Reusch».

- ➔ **Access** : 1) Cable car Reusch
2) Chairlift Martisberg
3) Cable car Cabane - Scex Rouge
- ➔ **Main restaurant** : is located at Col du Pillon
- ➔ **Last ride up** : 3pm **Last ride down** : 4.30pm
- ➔ **Duration** : 30 minutes (instead of 15 minutes)

FAQ

(FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS)

How many coaches can park in Reusch station?

10 coaches, for further coaches the parking Col du Pillon is available. Free parking.

Is Reusch accessible by public transport?

Yes postal bus stop is «Reusch, Talstation». Same bus than for Glacier 3000, one per hour (26 minutes from Gstaad, 29 minutes from Les Diablerets).

Where is the cash desk to get the cable car tickets?

There's a counter in Reusch station, next to the entry of the cable car.

How much is the capacity of the Reusch cable car?

34 pax.

How often is the Reusch cable car operating?

Every 20 minutes or every 10 minutes if necessary.

How long does it take from Reusch to Glacier 3000?

Reusch cable car is 6 minutes, Martisberg chairlift 10 minutes and Cabane - Glacier 3000 cable car 5 minutes. Total travel time with changes is 30 minutes.

How often is the Martisberg chairlift operating?

The chairlift is nonstop with chairs of 4 seats each (capacity is around 1,000 people per hour).

Any advice on passenger equipment?

Bring warm clothing (jacket, good shoes, scarf, gloves), especially for chairlift rides.

Is the Col du Pillon restaurant still open?

Yes, with the usual opening hours (5 minutes by car from Reusch station).

Is the restaurant «Le Carnotzet» still open for FIT travelers?

Yes, with the usual opening hours.
